## Officer Down Rescue!

Unfortunately, the pictures depicted on this brochure are ones that we are all too familiar with seeing, but it doesn't always have end up this way.



However, we are all just a radio call away from a situation

where we, or one of our colleagues, may find ourselves in a life or death situation.

The nightmare scenario that is unfortunately becoming all too common is a police officer down and injured while still in the line of fire. There may be no time to wait for SWAT or other specialty units and a rescue must immediately take place. Rescuing a downed officer who is still in the line of fire is a skill that is not often taught to patrol officers or detectives, but can be invaluable when the chips are down. This course will cover a wide range of scenarios and will demonstrate a wide range of options.

## Course Contents

This 2-day course focuses on providing law enforcement trainers the skills and knowledge necessary to provide training to their own officers upon returning to their respective agencies. Through hands-on applications, attendees will examine key teaching points aimed at making this course understandable by officers that may encounter an officer down situation where something has to be done, *NOW!*

- This course will examine several actual officer down incidents with a focus on what went right, what went wrong and what could have been done to improve the ability of the street officers to effect a safe rescue.
- The course will teach, in a hands-on manner, tactics for rescuing a downed officer or civilian in a building, open area or a vehicle.
- The course will show several field expedient modes of extracting downed officers such as using patrol cars and other vehicles or tools that are commonly available to patrol officers and detectives during their tour of duty.

**Who Should Attend:** The course is applicable to SWAT, tactical team members, patrol supervisors and trainers in general who wish to understand, utilize and present to others the concepts for creating highly effective extrication methods for removing other law enforcement officers and civilians from situations where the likelihood of death may occur.
